The NFI Wood/Gas/Pellet Exam covers the following: Fundamental Knowledge (25% of exam), Combustion, Heat/Heat Protection, Safety Guidelines & Consequences of Action, Construction Fundamentals, Installation Knowledge (75% of exam), Regulations and Instructions, Fuel Delivery, Appliance Requirements, Post Installation Inspection and Service. The reference manual for this certification is the 2009 HEARTH Reference Manual Wood/Gas/Pellet Hearth Systems.
